2.21.01.2011 Mr. Mittal, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner, submitted that as the factory of the petitioner was closed for about six months, time to deposit the rest 25% of the amounts assessed may be extended by six weeks. He further pointed out that the respondents did not restore the line within 48 hours as per the order of the court, rather it was restored after about 10 days.

Be that as it may. The order dated 15.12.2010 passed in W.P.(C) No. 5455 of 2010 is modified to the extent that the petitioner will deposit rest 25% of the amounts assessed within four weeks from today.

The order dated 15.12.2010 is modified to this extent only.
